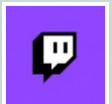

Capital Campaign and Projects

One of the most essential parts of our infrastructure is the movement of air. We use our large air handler to pull in cool air during Spring, Summer, and Fall. We use it during the Winter to circulate our air warmed by the boiler. It moves the air cooled by our air conditioner.

This past week I had some work done on our near-70 year old machine: new bearings, shaft, motor, and belt. Even this somewhat simple upgrade should be noticeable this Spring - a more powerful motor and repaired mechanisms.

History Fair 2026

For this year's *History Fair*, our 8th graders were tasked with researching an obsolete product that we no longer use from the 19th and 20th centuries and how it was replaced. Currently in the world today, we are faced with advancing technology and shifting customs/traditions. The amount of change we experience in our lifetimes is truly exceptional. Objects and practices that are commonplace can very quickly become outmoded. All the 8th grade students assumed the role of "Invention Archaeologist" and selected an item that was essential in the 19th or 20th century, but is now considered obsolete as of 2026. The goal was to track the technology from its invention and how societal shifts led to its replacement. Students were required to create a Tri-fold presentation board on their selected product and present it during our *Catholic Schools Week* open house.
