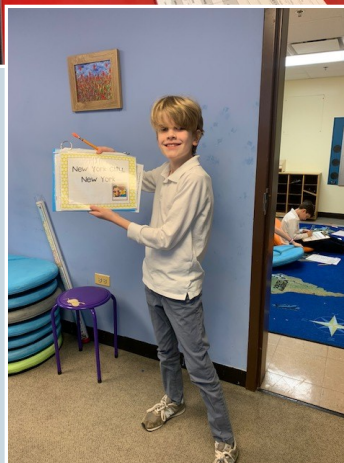
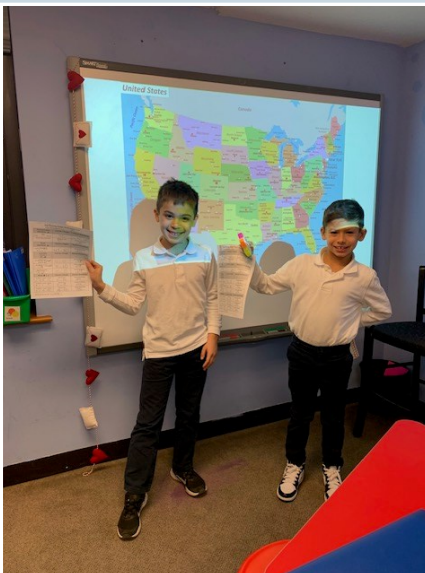
Many of them also joined our community for our Lenten Vespers Service that evening as well, which welcomed 70-80 people on Tuesday, March 26th.

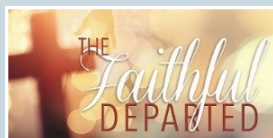

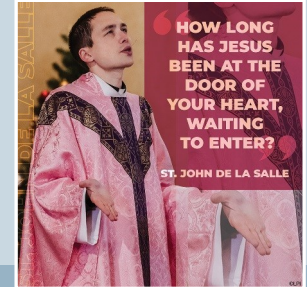
