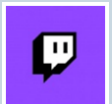

Testimonial Tuesday: Revealing The Holy Spirit @ Work In Our Community



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, today we launch a new outreach program entitled "*Testimonial Tuesday*". Can We Feel The Holy Spirit?

In the early phase of our spiritual formation, the Holy Spirit is often poorly understood as it concerns His nature and action - I fell into that category, more or less, until I enrolled in our Alpha program. I am a longtime IC parishioner who has always been active and participated in the liturgy, including attending daily Mass for several years now. You can say that much of my spiritual formation has happened here at IC among all of you, my brothers and sisters in Christ.

Let me start from the beginning, **who is the Holy Spirit?** From what I have learned, it is the powerful tide with which God, who is perfect Love, cares for the world and each one of us individually. How we become aware of this providential whirlwind is the purpose and fruit of our spiritual progress. As always, God will not force us into this deep understanding, but He expects us to discover it by following the inspirations of His Spirit.

How do we know it is the Holy Spirit talking to us? We can be sure it is the Holy Spirit at work when we receive a nudge to best follow the example of Jesus and to be a part in His plan of salvation. This means that we should not expect to become inspired in choosing the perfect car to buy, or any other inconsequential decision, but we can expect His help in finding a way to help others in need, or in helping someone make spiritual progress.

To this very point, I would like to mention a pertinent example of what happened to me recently when I felt a strong inspiration to become involved and help a family in need. One of our relatives in his fifties suffered a severe downturn in health: from a poorly managed type 1 diabetes to a series of strokes that have confined him to a wheelchair, unable to stand on his feet. During the week, he is home alone and ill-prepared to take care of his basic needs. His kids, both married, work, and his wife must also work to provide insurance coverage, and because he lost his business, they cannot afford a caregiver. Consequently, he has been falling often and when that happens, he is unable to get up on his own.

I remembered my wife mentioning that he had fallen again and it took a few hours before the family found out due to their work schedules. While I was thinking about it, this clear and persistent thought came into my mind: why don't I give him some of my time, perhaps two hours twice a week? This thought became a strong determination to call and set up a schedule. I cannot tell you how important and consequential this decision has been; since then, following my example, other members of the family have lined up and offered some of their time to the great relief of his overworked wife.

My involvement is ongoing and I feel so fortunate to have been given both the opportunity to help a person in need and the courage to not look for excuses. Great things happen when we surrender to the Holy Spirit and follow His Inspirations as He will remove some of the obstacles and make our work a good experience.

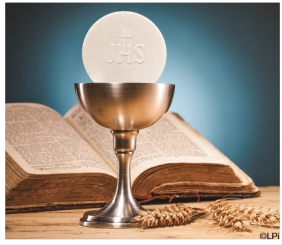

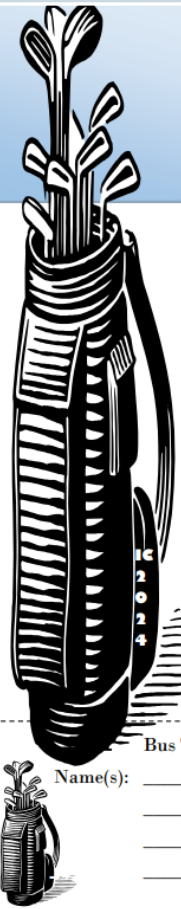
