#### Our Summer Scripture Conference

When I became Pastor 4 years ago, part of my vision involved Leadership. Leadership is what drives the life of any parish – but what is a leader?

A leader is not just someone who runs a ministry or an activity. Just about anyone, with a little instruction, can do anything. The notion of Leadership for me is a bit higher:



A leader is someone who actively involves themselves in the life of the parish. They make an effort to know people outside of their immediate circle and interests. They are connected to the community, with Christ at the center of their lives. They engage in prayer, but also worship regularly. Lastly, they are willing to grow for themselves and for others.

Thus, the past few years, I have wanted to invest in such individuals. From past conferences have come the desire and inspiration for ministries such as our Teen Club, Evangelization Team, Alpha Program, and Intercessory Prayer Group.

This past week, I had the privilege of taking five parishioners to *Franciscan University* in *Steubenville*, *Ohio* to a conference on the Psalms.

*Jocelyn, Maureen, Cheryl, Paul,* and *Robert* accompanied me to what was a quick, but very packed conference. Thursday alone saw four keynote addresses, two workshops, Mass, Adoration, and prayer. Witnessing their enjoyment of a part of parish life that each of them have been invested in was very gratifying. We look forward to sharing more with you, from them, in the coming weeks.

The center of the conference spoke of the Psalms as a library of prayers, but also a sort of spiritual history modeled after the life of *King David*. The Book of Psalms, as expressed by *Pope St. Leo X*, "is the privileged language of prayer in the *Church*." Since Jesus himself prayed the Psalms, he likewise confirmed their power and usefulness for us.

In that same way, you may have noticed that I have made efforts to introduce the Psalmody to parish life through Vespers, Liturgy of the Hours, and other such prayers. My plan is to increase these efforts and further introduce you to the richness of this Book of Scripture.

Similarly, to be together with 500-600 others who desired to grow in their faith is always inspiring. Praying the Mass

together with other priests and attending workshops as varied as art history, theological insight, and how to bring prayer into our family lives (to name a few) - there certainly was a lot to take in within a short period of time.

For now, I want to thank our five parishioners who accompanied me, sacrificing a bit of their time and comfort and, hopefully, growing a bit in the process. I am excited already to see what their experience has inspired within them, and in our parish, and I look forward to future opportunities with people. - Fr. Matt





#### A Special Announcement From Our Professional Cantor, Rosemary




