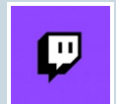

This Lent, We Must Fast & Pray

When I was on retreat this past week, it struck me that living a simpler life helped me to see how my prayer had become shallower. Even if I rationally knew this was the case, there is something to be said of physically removing yourself from your day-to-day life to see it. A regular routine of prayer. A regular routine of meals. A priority on God and, in some ways, yourself. This is the Lent I hope for all of you. If you are following us on the *Hallow App*, I have just created a small group that will be dedicated to fasting and prayer. We are called to Fast on **Ash Wednesday**, and then abstain from meat on Fridays. We are also called to pray and 'give alms.'

I would like this small group to be a little more intensive and a little more intentional:

1. Abstaining from meat or *Fasting* more often

For those who can, I would like others to join me by fasting every Wednesday and Friday in Lent. **Fasting** means either to abstain from all food (which is difficult and not advised for beginners) or eating plain and small meals during the day. Alternatively, if fasting is not advised due to health issues, abstain from meat on both days. Fasting is an act of discipline and purifying our hearts. It is about self-control and confronting our impulses. It is also a prayer.

2. To *Pray* every day, intentionally

For those in the small group, I would like to encourage praying the **Liturgy of the Hours**—the official prayers of the Church—at least at Morning Prayer (*Matens*) and Evening Prayer (*Vespers*). There are free websites and apps for this, such as **DivineOffice.org** and **IBreviary** [app and website]. These prayers are structured as: Hymn, 3 Psalms, a short reading of Scripture, praying the prayer of Zechariah (John the Baptist's Father) or the Virgin Mary, Petitions, and a closing prayer. Each prayer takes 12 - 17 minutes, so about 30 minutes of intentional prayer per day.

I am asking us to do this as a community in some capacity for the following intentions:

+For conversion of hearts here at Immaculate Conception

Each of us are in need to grow closer to God, let us pray for each other and strengthen each other in our own sacrifices.

+For a greater commitment of our community to the Eucharist and Confession

My wish is that more than ever our brothers and sisters see richness in regular participation of Sunday Worship and of this great sacrament of healing.

+For the healing of those who have become indifferent to faith

We all have been wounded and hurt—by the world, by the Church, by each other. We have wounded others. We fast and pray to make amends, but also to encounter and experience God's daily love for us.

I hope that you can join me this Lenten Season, and I hope that our community can grow as a result. Know that I will be praying and fasting for you,
