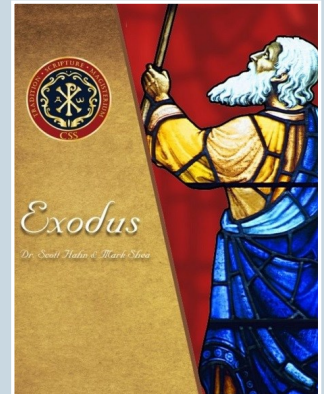
*Exploring Scripture Monday Mornings: Exploring The Book Of Exodus*

In 28 revealing lessons, you will learn:

- *What sacrament the Crossing of the Red Sea prefigures*
- *Why we shouldn't be afraid to study the Old Testament*
- *How God responds to us when we try to run ahead of him*



In the Christian life, everyone is a pilgrim. What God told Moses thousands of years ago still applies to us today: God will fit us for our tasks.
