

Our Journey Through Ordinary Time

Recently, while walking by our church's altar, the space there seemed very empty to me once our Christmas décor was taken down. I had become accustomed to seeing our lit Christmas trees and our beautiful nativity scene filling up this sacred space. You might have had the same impression, or perhaps you noticed that the priest and the deacon are now wearing a green vestment and dalmatic during our Mass. Of course, all of these are signs that we have transitioned into the Ordinary Time of our liturgical calendar.



The Catholic Church's liturgical calendar has a profound meaning. In one way, it can be seen as a tapestry that guides the faithful through the mysteries of Christ's life, death, and resurrection. Each season carries its own unique themes, prayers, colors, etc., which are meant to deepen our spiritual life and help us to reflect on our faith. Advent is, of course, a season of hopeful anticipation for the birth of Christ, followed by the joyous celebration of Christmas. After Christmas, the Church transitions into Ordinary Time. The other familiar season, which begins this year with Ash Wednesday on March 5th, is Lent. It is a time of penance and preparation for Easter. The celebration of the Resurrection of Christ, concludes with Pentecost, marking the descent of the Holy Spirit and the beginning of the Church's mission until Christ's return at the end of times.

Ordinary Time in the liturgical calendar might sound plain, but it is far from ordinary. This season, which happens twice a year, focuses on the life and teachings of Jesus during His public ministry. The word "ordinary" comes from the Latin ordinalis, meaning numbered, since the Sundays in this season are counted. It is God's time of grace given to us to help us grow in faith, reflecting on the everyday aspects of discipleship, like prayer, acts of love, and living out the Gospel. Ordinary Time may not have the dramatic highs of Christmas or Easter, but it is where our faith can truly take root—in the steady rhythm of life, in our daily tasks of housekeeping, work and school.

The color green, used in this season, symbolizes growth and life, inviting us to nurture our relationship with God in the ordinary moments of life. Through our daily and Sunday Scripture readings, we hear about Jesus' miracles, parables, and His call to follow Him, encouraging us to bring His message into our daily routines. So, as we make our way through this season of the Church, let us remember that every moment of "Ordinary Time" is an opportunity to have an "extraordinary" encounter with Christ.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA): Rites of Entrance (Catechumens) and Welcoming (Candidates)








