A QCD gift (a.k.a. IRA charitable rollover) allows individuals age 70<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> or older to authorize their IRA administrator to make a direct transfer of funds from their IRA to qualified charities, tax-free. This way of giving does not generate taxable income, which may lower your annual income level, and the amount you transfer may count towards your required minimum distribution.


