#### THE MISSION WORK IN THE ARCHDIOCESE OF KUMASI, GHANA

The Archdiocese of Kumasi in Ghana (West Africa), was established by the early missionaries in 1950. During these past years, there has been a tremendous growth of the Church in Ghana.

The Kumasi Archdiocese is located in the central part of Ghana. It has both rural and urban parishes. We undertake many projects as a means of evangelization to help our rural communities and the people of the diocese. We provide good and portable drinking water for rural communities. Many of these rural folks fetch water from the stream and rivers, which are polluted by the activities of Illegal Mining for Gold. The diocese helps to provide Wells and Boreholes to such deprived communities and rural schools so that people can have decent water to drink.



Very young people migrate from the rural communities to the cities in search of jobs. Unfortunately, when they come, there are no job opportunities for them. Some end up on the street and some of the young girls get abused, become pregnant and some of the young boys also get into bad companies/groups. The diocese is hosting a program called "Catholic Action for Street Children". In this project, we house many of these young people and those who are capable of going to school, we put them back into school and those who cannot are placed into technical, vocational and computer training so that they can have an opportunity for a decent life for themselves in the future.

We provide education for young people, particularly at the basic level by providing or maintaining some educational facilities for the rural communities. As part of the education, we train young teachers posted to deprived communities as Catechists to help the mission Churches.







Most Rev. Gabriel J. Anokye, the Archbishop of Kumasi, expresses his gratitude to the Church in America and acknowledges that the generosity of American Catholics has immensely improved the condition of many people of Kumasi and has aided the growth of the Church in Africa as a whole.

We thank you in much anticipation for your generosity and hospitality offered to our missionary representative, *Rev. Anthony Darko*, who will be visiting your parish community this weekend and for the financial support you offer. Your parish family will be remembered in Masses and prayers offered by the priests, deacons, religious, and missionaries serving in the

Archdiocese of Kumasi, Ghana. God's Blessings be with you and your families.



#### Serving Others...

#### Question:

I volunteer every once in a while. How can I incorporate serving the poor in my everyday life?

#### Answer:

In the Gospels, Jesus is very clear about emphasizing outreach to vulnerable persons on the margins of society. These may be the materially poor, the disabled, the lonely, or any others whose circumstances drive them from mainstream society. We can all respond to Christ's call to love by incorporating direct service into our regular life routine. Here are some ideas to find your niche:

*Consider your life.* Before you look for direct service opportunities, consider your schedule, commitment levels, and personal gifts. When can you help out and how regularly? Where have you volunteered in the past that has felt like a good fit? Do you have any particular skills or personality traits that lend you to particular work?

**Do some research.** There are a lot of structured ways you can get involved in your community. Your parish might have a social concerns outreach program. If not, ask friends and family. A simple online search for local nonprofits can also expose you to new opportunities.

**Be open to God's invitation.** The chance to serve may be closer than you think. Befriending an elderly neighbor, widowed and far from children, is an act of serving the poor. Keep your eyes and heart open!  $\bigcirc$ LPi


