

Last weekend, as a part of our annual Summer Missionary Co-Op Appeal, we warmly welcomed *Fr. Anthony Darko*, a missionary representative from the *Archdiocese of Kumasi* in Ghana (West Africa). *Fr. Anthony* celebrated all of our weekend Masses and reflected upon the vital mission work that his diocese undertakes as a means of evangelization to help the rural communities and people of the *Kumasi Diocese*, including projects aimed at providing basic necessities (such as good & portable drinking water and housing) as well as educational opportunities and technical & vocational training to help provide young people with a chance at a better future.

Disciples In Mission

Disciplines in Mission continues to work with Exodus World Service (EWS) in its support of refugees in Chicago. Even though new refugees are not being accepted into the US, those that are here receive services from EWS to support their economic and cultural transitions. We recently have been helping with food and household supplies.



In one instance, EWS alerted us of a family that had experienced a theft and were struggling with the means to purchase groceries. In that instance, members of *Disciples in Mission* supported a Congolese multi-generational family of seven living in West Rogers Park. Using the grocery list provided by EWS so that we knew what foods the family needed and were culturally preferred, we were able to obtain the majority of the items and delivered them to the great appreciation of the family, who wanted to cook for us on the spot! As volunteers, we loved learning something about another culture and "serving our neighbors" as Jesus has served us.

Additionally, EWS informed us of an Afghan family of eight that was in need of general household items. Members of *Disciples in Mission* were able to obtain and deliver the items to the family, who invited us into their home and showed us kindness and appreciation by sharing their story. The father was an interpreter for the US Government in Afghanistan. Through their journey to arrive in the US, they spent two years in Brazil as part of the vetting process. Their children have all learned English in 6 months. They are a loving family, proud of their heritage, and also very grateful for the opportunity to come to the United States.

Mary Magdalene

Norwood Park Historical Society Events:

Question:

July 22nd *is the feast of Mary Magdalene. I've heard a lot of stories about her, but who was she really?*

Answer:

Mary Magdalene has been the subject of speculation and scholarship over the last 2,000 years. Mary Magdalene makes her first named appearance in Luke 8:2. She is one of several women following Jesus. Luke specifically mentions that Mary had previously been delivered from demonic possession. Whatever her life looked like before she met Jesus, it wasn't good! Because of this association with being a repentant sinner, Mary Magdalene has been associated with other similar stories in the Gospel, such as the woman caught in adultery or the woman who bathes Jesus' feet with her tears.

Mary Magdalene shows up again by name at the end of the Gospels, when she stands with the Blessed Virgin Mary at the foot of the Cross. Mary is also present in the garden of the resurrection. She is one of the women who goes to bring spices to Jesus' tomb, where they find the stone rolled away. Mary stays in the garden weeping, believing his body has been stolen. Jesus approaches her and calls her by name, and she becomes the first witness to the resurrection! While many of the details of Mary Magdalene's life have been lost to time, she is an example of powerful conversion, deep faith, and intimate love for Christ. ©LPi


