



2024 / 2025 Hope for Tanzania Projects (Goal = \$270,000)



Patroness of our 501(c)(3) entity

- Two apartment buildings (3 units each) for INUKA staff and their families. Need key staff onsite (primarily nurses) for the successful functioning of the new OR. It will also be helpful for staff recruiting.
- Implement operational improvement projects to reduce costs. They currently operate a modest farm and they would like chickens for egg consumption and sale, a couple of cows for milk, a fish pond, an improved pig containment, gardening in the greenhouse, and needed fencing. Most of what is produced here will first be to feed the children undergoing therapy and what remains will be sold for income.
- Improvements to the water system to support the growth of the INUKA operations.


