ervant of God Carlo Acutis, as an expert catechist, had continually sought to find increasingly new ways to help others reinforce their faith. For this reason he bequeathed to us as an inheritance his Exhibitions, among which is the very notable one on Eucharistic Miracles. It was precisely in 2002, while visiting the expositions of the Meeting of Rimini, that Carlo had decided to organize an exhibition on the Eucharistic Miracles recognized by the Church. A demanding commitment in which even his family members were involved for nearly two and a half years. The spiritual effects being brought about by this Exhibition were unpredictable on the eve of the project. To this day we can affirm that the Exhibition has been hosted in all 5 Continents thanks to the generous contribution of several very special people, among whom stand out the members of the Real Presence Eucharistic Education and Adoration Association who assisted so very much in this undertaking.

Finally in 2014 we have succeeded in bringing also to completion this exhibition, dedicated to the Virgin Mary, which Carlo had initiated in 2006 but was unable to finish due to the sudden onset of a fulminating leukemia that brought him to Heaven within a few days. The young Servant of Cod Carlo Acutis was profoundly marked in his spiritual journey by the Virgin Mary, "humble and high beyond any creature" (Dante Alighieri), and he established from the inception the objective of imitating her in all of her virtues. The Virgin Mary was for him the highest example of purity and of unconditional love for God. Mary Most Holy revealed to mankind the image of that which the Church, a wanderer upon the earth, will be one day—at the end of this world. We know that for each Christian, holiness is achieved only through an intense life of Faith, Hope, and Charity. Of all three of these theological virtues, Carlo wrote that Mary "is an exemplary model and

her example of faith, supported by her perfect charity, must encourage us to continue in our journey toward holiness regardless of our fragility."

Because of this, the motive is well understood that drove Carlo to be continually interested in all of the manifestations of the Virgin Mary which, for more than two millennia, like very bright stars, have illuminated the path for multitudes of people. "Surely", Carlo said, "the miracles accomplished by the Virgin Mary during her apparitions on earth can be of a great help to increase the Faith of many people... How can they be ignored", he often asked, "the appeals that Our Lady gave us? And yet", he said, "knowing our little Faith, in her maternal goodness, the Blessed Mother wanted to work countless numbers of miracles precisely to help us to believe, yet despite these amazing signs many, still today, remain so indifferent" Carlo used to say that "many people seek signs from Heaven to reinforce their Faith, but there are also many who unfortunately do not even seek them and if by chance they find them, intentionally ignore them because they are too preoccupied with worldly things."

However, he never lost spirit, because he nourished in his heart the ever lively hope that, sooner or later, the Guardian Angels would have created favorable circumstances in order to sensitize souls that were distant from God to embark upon a life more consistent with His Laws. Our wish, like Carlos, is that through this exhibition many will rediscover the path which leads to God and that they, too, are able to become bearers of light to all those who are still in darkness.



Assistive Listening Devices Available @ IC

IC offers the following options to assist our parishioners and guests who require assistive listening devices:

Hearing Accessibility Streaming Network: This app allows our church sound system to stream directly to a hearing aid or cochlear implant user's personal device through their cell phone in order to hear the readings, sermons and song lyrics with ease. In order to access the network, please follow the steps below:

- 1. Connect your phone to the Wifi Network called, "IC Listen" using the password: "Immaculate" (please note the capital "I").
- 2. Download the *WaveCast* App.
- 3. Open the *WaveCast* App and select the network called, "FM_PLUS."
- 4. Once you are connected, you should be able to hear our church audio streaming directly through your hearing aids or cochlear implants. You can adjust the volume using the slider within the app. Sliding to the right turns up the volume and sliding to the left turns down the volume.

In addition to this streaming network, we also have some other assistive listening devices available for check out from our ushers/greeters:

Telecoil NeckLoop: This device works as a transmitter, collecting our church's sound signal and sending it directly to the user's hearing aids or cochlear implants. This is the ideal option for a hearing aid or cochlear implant user who does not have a smartphone that is connected to their devices. In order for this Telecoil NeckLoop to work, the hearing aids or cochlear implants must be in a "telecoil program." If you are unsure if your device has this program, ask your audiologist.

Wireless Receiver: This device is best for someone who would like to hear better, but does not have their own set of hearing aids or cochlear implants. It also works as a transmitter, collecting our church's sound signal and sending it directly to the user's ears via headphones. You can use the headphones provided by our church or bring your own set of headphones and connect them to the device.

If you need any assistance setting up the smartphone app or assistive listening devices, please feel free to speak with a member of our greeter team or parish staff.

Among the saints, we have doctors, lawyers, farmers, and stay-at-home moms. No matter your daily tasks, God can be present there!

One way concerns behavior. Start with an examination of conscience. Look at areas where you tend to struggle to imitate Christ at work. Do you gossip? Does brimming frustration become impatience at home? Pick one sin you struggle with, then choose a virtue to strengthen that area. If you tend to speak poorly of your co-workers, resolve to stop and to say one kind thing a day instead.

Another way relates to perspective, particularly your perspective of others. Jesus' incarnation reminds us of the value of every human being. Jesus is God, and each of us is created in God's image. When you encounter another person, you have an opportunity to see God in a new place and a new way - in that person in front of you. Genuinely listen to them and be present to their concerns. Loving your neighbor is loving God! Our relationship with God and the love He inspires in our hearts shouldn't remain only at church on Sunday. 
