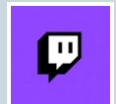

National Eucharistic Congress: July 17th through July 21st

This July is the National Eucharistic Congress. I suppose a little context is important for what we will be doing to celebrate it here at Immaculate Conception.

Begun in France in 1881, the First Eucharistic Congress was entitled “*The Eucharist Saves the World.*” International in scope, it united Catholics around Europe in devotion.



Some years later, in 1924, Cardinal George Mundelein hosted it in Chicago. He “began advocating for the next Eucharistic Congress to be held in Chicago. He told Pope Pius XI, “*Holy Father, permit the celebration of the next Eucharistic Congress to take place in Chicago and I promise you a million communions as a spiritual bouquet to your august presence.*” The planning commission selected Soldier Field – current home of the Chicago Bears – to host several of the largest Masses. Planners also worked with railroad and steamship companies to plan for the transportation of hundreds of thousands of pilgrims to and from Chicago. Religious sisters made over 4.5 million hosts for the Masses[.]” (excerpted from an article by Stephanie Shreffler, University of Dayton)

Such a lavish display can still be seen at the Mundelein Seminary Museum. Now, one hundred years later, the Eucharistic Congress is being celebrated in the United States again. Pilgrimages and processions with the Eucharist are taking place at the four corners of the United States as millions converge on Indianapolis.

The Congress, as it was 140 years ago, is a call to renewal and devotion in the Eucharist. The current statistics are troubling – nearly 75% of professed Catholics do not believe in the Real Presence of the Eucharist (i.e., that the Eucharist truly is the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, really *and* sacramentally present in the bread and wine, transformed by ritual words and actions). It is alarming because the Passover we celebrate is the central moment of the world’s redemption (the Lord’s Passion) and an expression of our unity with God and all the Baptized.

As such, the Congress will once again call all men and women of good will to prayer and renewal, that we may kneel before the Lord of All. To commemorate this moment in history, we will also offer moments of prayer at IC in conjunction with the Congress. Please review our schedule below:

Wednesday, July 17th –

5:00 P.M. – Adoration with Vespers at **6:30 P.M.**

Thursday, July 18th –

5:00 P.M. – Adoration with Benediction

6:30 P.M. – A discussion on Bishop Barron’s book, ‘*This is My Body*’ (available for free at our Church and Parish Office)

Friday, July 19th –

5:00 P.M. – Adoration with Confessions* until

6:30 P.M. (*multiple priests available)

Saturday, July 20th –

5:00 P.M. – Mass with a Prayer for Healing, offering Anointing of the Sick to all seeking the Sacrament.

Sunday, July 21st –

10:30 A.M. – Mass, which is concurrent with the close of the Congress. Our Mass will combine Morning Prayer (sung psalms in praise of God’s goodness).

The exhibition, designed and created by Blessed Carlo Acutis, will be displayed in our Rectory Assembly after all Masses on the weekend of June 29th & 30th.

With an extensive assortment of photographs and historical descriptions, the exhibition presents some of the principal Eucharistic Miracles that took place throughout the ages in various countries of the world and which have been recognized by the Church. By means of the panels, one can "virtually visit" the places where the miracles took place. The current exhibition includes 153 panels that are used to explain 152 Eucharistic Miracles with an additional 22 country and historical panel maps (60x80 cm). Due to space limitations, our exhibit will be about half this size.

The exhibition has already visited well over 3000 parishes in Italy, the USA, Canada and in many other countries as well and has been translated into numerous languages. At this event, the faithful will be able to read about the miracles in English.

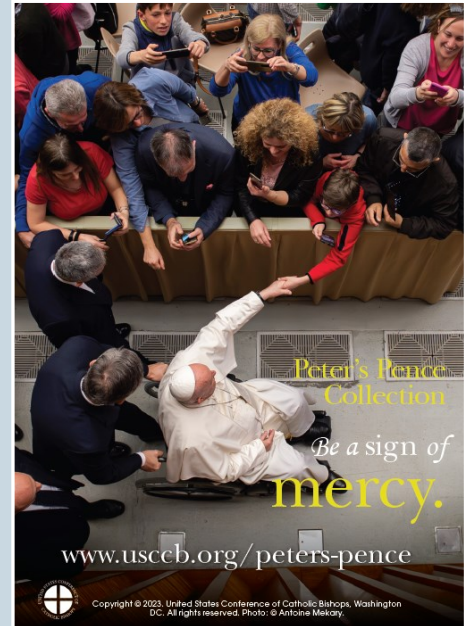
Next weekend, we will take up the Peter's Pence Collection to support the Universal Church and the work of the Holy See, including helping Pope Francis to carry out his charitable works.

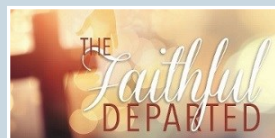

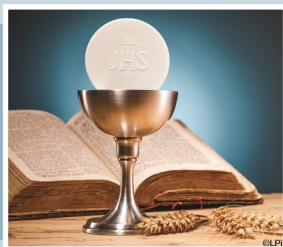

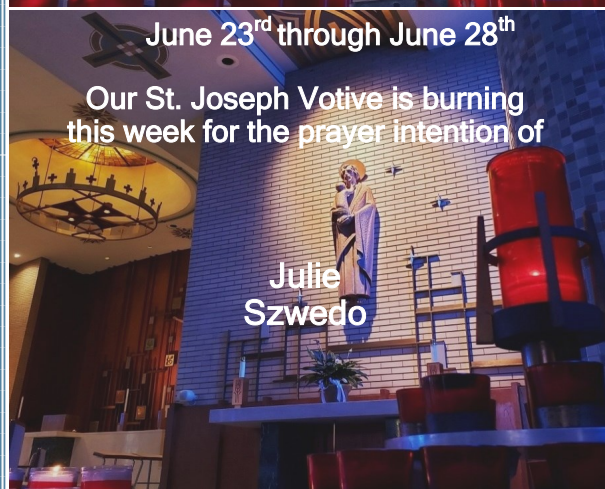

- e. One candidate from Asian/Pacific Islander community and one candidate from the Black Catholic community

II. Weaknesses (areas for growth)

- a. Overall number remains low: 31 seminarians
- b. No candidates in 2024 from the Polish communities

III. Opportunities

- a. Growth with candidates for college seminary

IV. Threats

- a. Pace of life for priests and discerners
- b. Fear of commitment for candidates
- c. Lack of parental support, either for seminary or Totus Tuus

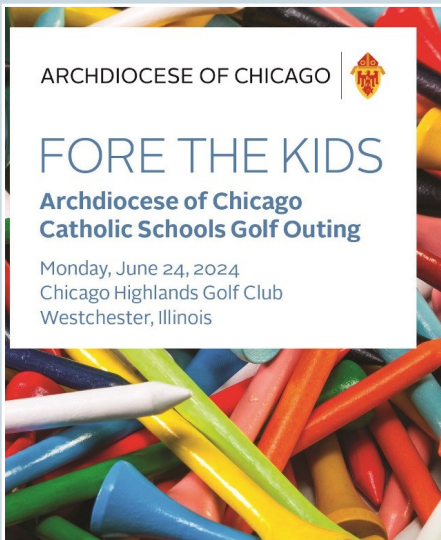
