Pentecost Sunday...

This Sunday, we joyfully celebrate Pentecost, one of the most powerful feasts in the liturgical year. Fifty days after Easter, the Church remembers the day when the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles in the Upper Room filling them with courage, wisdom, and the ability to proclaim the Gospel to all peoples. Only shortly before, they were filled with fear and confusion because of the experience of Jesus' crucifixion. But now their hearts have been healed and their minds are filled with an understanding of God's plan of salvation and Christ's victory over death through Resurrection.



Pentecost is thus referred to as the "birthday of the Church," marking the moment of transformation of the small group of frightened disciples into bold witnesses of Christ. The Acts of the Apostles tells us that "tongues as of fire" rested upon them, and they began to speak in different languages, enabling them to reach out to the different crowds gathered in Jerusalem. From that day on, the Good News began to go out into the world.

That experience of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, is the very same Holy Spirit that animates the Church and all of us believers today. The Holy Spirit is the living presence of God among us. As Jesus promised,


the Spirit would teach, guide, remind, and strengthen the Church until the end of time. It is the Spirit who animates the sacraments, breathes life into Scripture, inspires the teachings of the Church, and raises up saints in our times. Through the Holy Spirit, the Church remains

very alive.

In our more immediate context, here at Immaculate Conception Parish, the Holy Spirit is present every time we gather in Christ's name: at Mass, in individual prayer, in ministry, in service projects, and in the schooling of our children. The Holy Spirit unites us and gives each of us gifts that are necessary to continue the mission of building up the Body of Christ. As we put these gifts into practice, we produce the fruits of the Holy Spirit that can benefit the entire parish and the community around us.

As we celebrate this holy feast together, let us ask for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit in our lives and in our parish. May He deepen our relationship with Christ, renew our zeal for the Gospel, and help us become sharers of our faith to our families and friends.






Celebrating Grandparents' Day @ IC

Lectio Divina: Tuesday, June 17th @ IC

Question:

What is Lectio Divina, and how is it associated with the Benedictine Monastic tradition, whose founder, St. Benedict, we honor on July 11th?

Answer:

Benedict desired his monks to live in community, praying the Liturgy of the Hours together, contemplating sacred texts, and doing manual labor. The monks developed a technique to facilitate a spiritual and devotional reading of the Bible known as Lectio Divina, the holy reading of a text. This method encourages the reader to hear the biblical text with an open heart and focus on whatever God wants to highlight and then apply it to daily life.



There are variations on Lectio Divina, but essentially, the technique consists of a three-step process of reflection. When the reflection is done with a group, the responses are shared by all the participants. Once the text is selected, it is read meditatively, and the following are then explored: a word or phrase that attracts you; how and where the content of this reading touches your life today; what you believe that God wants you to do during this coming week (month, year, lifetime).

Thanks to Benedict, the Christian community has been gifted with this special way of entering into the biblical text. This week, use the Lectio Divina process on one of the readings for the coming Sunday and make a note of the life connections you are making. How is this reflection on the biblical text drawing you closer to God and others? ©LPi


