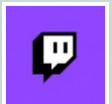

Saturday, March 14th @ 5:00 P.M. & Sunday, March 15th @ 10:30 A.M.

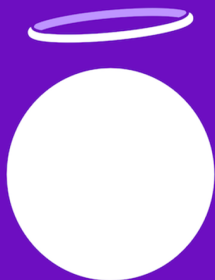
Both Masses will be celebrated with a special intention for healing and grace for participants, their families, and for all those in need of Christ's merciful touch.
