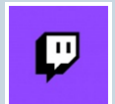

Through the Generation to Generation: Answer the Call campaign, we will not only play a significant role in this historic moment in the church's history, but we will also support new and exciting projects at our parish. Through much prayer, planning, and conversation, we have identified our greatest needs and initiatives to strengthen our mission and vision for years to come. IMPROVING ACCESSIBILITY

We will replace the existing wheelchair lift to the Rectory Assembly with a new, reliable elevator that meets ADA standards. The Church and Rectory Assembly restrooms, original to the 1960s, will also be refurbished with new fixtures, tile, and ADA-compliant doorways. Together, these improvements will create a more accessible and welcoming environment, allowing everyone to gather comfortably for parish programs, community events, and sacramental celebrations at the heart of our parish life.

IC Cares Day: Uncle Pete's Ministry March 28th

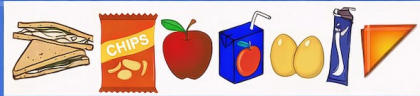

WHO IS UNCLE PETE: Pete Zonsius, better known as "Uncle Pete," was a long-time parishioner at St. John Brebeuf. He started a ministry to feed the less fortunate. He would load a van with bagged lunches and personally distribute them to those in need. When he passed away in 2012 at age 90, St. John Brebeuf parishioners continued his ministry, along with other parishes who have joined the efforts.

HOW DOES IT WORK: Lunch sacks and directions will be given out after Mass on **March 21 & 22**. Return one or more filled sacks on **Saturday, March 28** between **9:00 AM and 11:00 AM** to volunteers stationed outside the IC cafeteria. Later that day, the sacks will be distributed to those in need.

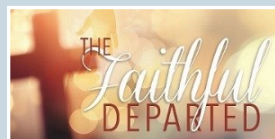

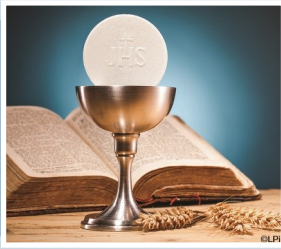

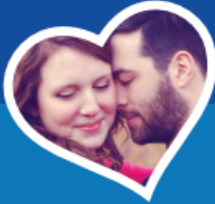
