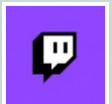

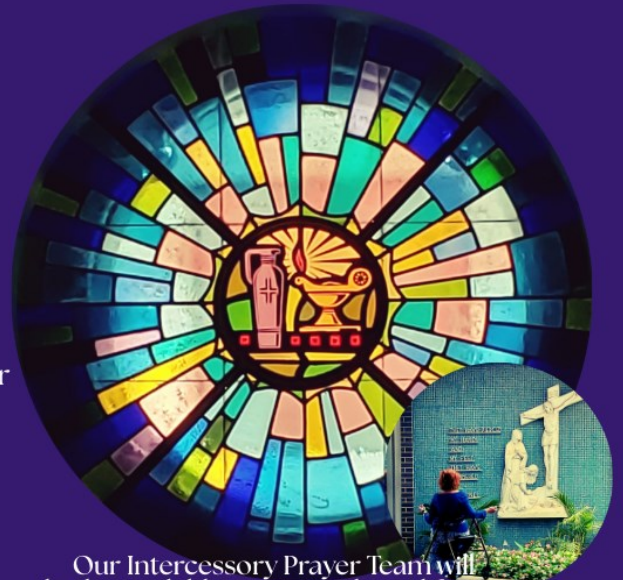


Healing Mass with Anointing of the Sick

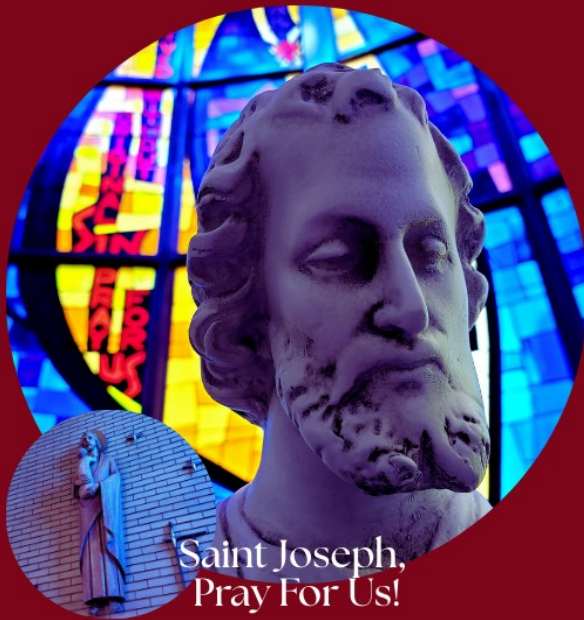
Saturday, March 14th & Sunday, March 15th
