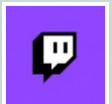

Some Parish Updates

After I returned from my trip with my parents, I immediately got back to work as May is perhaps the busiest month of the year at IC: First Communion, Graduation, year-end wrap ups, and preparation for the Summer.

My first acknowledgment is to our **Parents Club and School** as two large and noticeable changes will be taking place very soon: a new sign in our main parking lot and a new floor, painting, and mats in our small gym (formerly the old church in the 30s, 40s, and 50s).



The new gym floor and renovation was made possible by the **Boosterthon** in February and the generosity of parents, grandparents, parishioners, and neighbors. The small gym, as it is referred to, is the central room of the school. It is an often-used space that is, in some ways, the face of the school interior. My thanks to everyone's generosity for this great upgrade that we will see in a few months.

Secondly, **the Blue & White Gala**, which took place in the fall and is run by our IC Parents Club, identified the sign on Talcott and Oconto as a project. Our current sign is limited to only a few words and has aged over time, but with a new digital sign we can provide a fresh look to one of the most public places on our campus. I think that you will notice the difference right away! Our Parents Club did a fantastic job to make this a reality.

Bequests:

Two other small projects are taking place as a result of bequests that we received. One family decided to renovate the grotto to Mary on the Harlem side of our church—a favorite spot of her parents who lived nearby. We have done the concrete and are looking forward to new trees and plants to beautify the Harlem side of our Campus. Once completed, I hope to invite the family to a Sunday Mass and rededicate the grotto to the Blessed Virgin.



Additionally, we have another bequest given for Masses to be said in memory of one of our longtime parishioners. For those Masses, I will select some sacred vessels to be used with our deceased sister's name engraved, so that Masses may be said in her honor and for the benefit of our community. Likewise, I hope to invite the family from out of town to bless and dedicate these items in honor of her.

It is a wonderful way to help our parish and beautify it by gifting a donation through a will or trust, either yourself or in a family member's name. I am grateful to everyone who thinks of IC in this way.

Capital Campaign:

Last week, I preached at all our Masses, and we received an additional \$65,000 towards our goal. With two full months to go, I anticipate each week we will progress steadily. I want to thank our 50 households who have given \$600,000; each gift is greatly appreciated. You may turn in your gift in the pledge envelope to our office or in our regular Sunday collection.
