Second Grade Experience Day: Saturday, April 13th

As a part of their preparation for First Communion, our First Communicants were invited to participate in an "Experience Day" where they gathered together with their parents on **Saturday, April 13th** to engage in varied activities and crafts designed to assist them in developing a better understanding and deeper appreciation for the Sacrament that they are about to receive. During this time, the children spent time in prayer, participated in dough-making (for unleavened bread – similar to the bread we use for Mass) and created their First Communion banners (which adorn the sides of our pews during our celebration of First Holy Communion on May 11th.) Children were also given the opportunity to freely explore our Church together with their families, taking special note of what our Church is attempting to teach them about the Eucharist. Proper preparation prior to receiving the Sacrament not only supports their spiritual growth, but it also begins to impress upon our children that, as they begin to be nourished by the Eucharist, they are called to serve others around them. Please keep our First Communicants in your prayers as we welcome them to the Lord's Table this weekend.
