#### Evangelization @ IC: Making Disciples & Being Missional

My dearest Brothers and Sisters, a very happy and blessed Pentecost Sunday!

I am reaching out today to provide you with a status update on our Evangelization Team @ IC. Over the last year, the team and I have been busy, embracing the call of "making Disciples" and of "being Missional". I have shared with the team my Vision of IC as well as a Mission Statement which defines the purpose of our team. Our Mission statement is as follows:



"The IC Evangelization Team is a collection of dedicated disciples of Jesus Christ.

As adopted Sons and Daughters of God, we fully acknowledge and embrace the Gift of the Holy Spirit that each of us has received. We endeavor to put our gifts into action and purposefully use them to invite others into a relationship with Christ, through Love, Humility, and Compassion."

As we debated and discussed what "making Disciples" and "being Missional" means, we realized that our purpose was leaning towards one of apostolic nature. When reciting the Nicene Creed, what does it mean to be an "Apostolic" Church? If the Church is truly Apostolic, then its members must be so too, by default. Since it takes a Disciple to make a Disciple, our team soon realized that the sharing of the Gospel is not the responsibility of the Church, but rather the responsibility of the members who are the Church. As the Church strives to renew itself, it must make Evangelization a priority, for the Mission of Immaculate Conception is to make Disciples. While this is easy to say, the execution thereof is an entirely different matter. For some parishioners, the very idea of talking about or sharing their faith with a neighbor is a completely foreign concept. We are simply not comfortable with the idea, nor have we ever been asked to do so. If the very act of "being Missional" was reserved for a very select few in the past, then it is very easy to see how the directive to do so now is completely foreign.

To this end, as we strive to embrace the call of renewal by "being Missional", our Evangelization Team realizes that opportunities for engagement are necessary to begin the process of relationship building within our community. As Alpha is IC's introduction to a relationship with Jesus, what steps are we taking to reach out to others to invite them into a relationship with us? That is, if we are reluctant to talk about our relationship with Christ to neighbors and/or strangers, what types of programs or offerings can we provide which will help break the initial ice, so that our neighbors are no longer strangers? Some of our current offerings include "IC Book Club", "Lectio Divina", "Alpha", etc. This is but a small sample of things that IC is currently offering for all to join. Some have already reached out to me about the idea of a monthly game night, or possibly a monthly movie night. The possibilities are endless, but they will not mean much if we are not inviting our neighbors to join us.

In an effort to get us comfortable talking about our faith (our personal relationship with Christ), our Evangelization Team is launching "Testimonial Tuesdays". Testimonial Tuesday is a platform for testimonials that can be shared with others via our Bulletin or Constant Contact email newsletter or via our YouTube Channel. By identifying how the Holy Spirit is active in our respective lives, we identify how the Holy Spirit is active throughout our entire Parish. As more stories roll in, the greater the presence of the Holy Spirit in our community. Your testimonial could be a simple personal reflection on a particular homily, or it could be as deep as you would like to share. Whatever its length, it is your retelling of how the Holy Spirit came to you in a particular place and time. And that is a story worth sharing. We would love to hear it.







#### Question:

How do we know when we receive the Holy Spirit?

#### Answer

My brothers and I discovered something as we got older. There's a little bit of dad in us. Each time we catch ourselves using one of his gestures, expressions, or comments about a meal, we say, "I'm getting more like Dad!" Many laughs and good-natured kidding have come out of it. Mom loves it, and so does Dad, although I doubt he'd admit it!

When we are confirmed, we receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit. There is no radical change in us that makes us seem suddenly different. Over a period of time, we come to see that there is a little bit of the Spirit in us. We catch ourselves using the gifts, and often end up wondering where a bit of wisdom came from, or why we were so patient or we feel an intensity in our prayer. Perhaps we felt drawn to deepen our spiritual life or found courage in witnessing to our faith. That's when we know we have received the Holy Spirit. We take on his image. Yes, we grow in age, grace and wisdom, but we also grow in our awareness and understanding of the working of God in our life. We become more godlike, realizing we're getting more and more like God. Our thoughts, words and actions carry that quality and others too, see it in us. You might call it holiness. But be confident! There's a little bit of him in all of us. ©LPi


