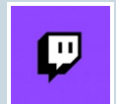

+ *Plans for the future*

One of the things that Pentecost urges us to consider is the "Great Commission."

"Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

Baptism is often just a moment, but discipleship is not a graduation after Baptism, First Communion, or Confirmation. It is a life of service and sacrifice, and of community and Church. *Fr. Michael* has been working hard with *Deacon Rick* and *Carol* to revamp our Baptismal Preparation. *Julie Szwedo* and I are working together on updating what we offer and how with our Religious Education Program. Likewise, I will be working with *Fr. Michael* and *Deacon Rick* to expand our offerings to those wishing to enter the church, either by Baptism or conversion.

My priority for this summer and the following year is an improvement and growth of our parish through those people seeking our Lord in and through the prayer, grace, and sacraments of the Church. I hope you can pray for us!

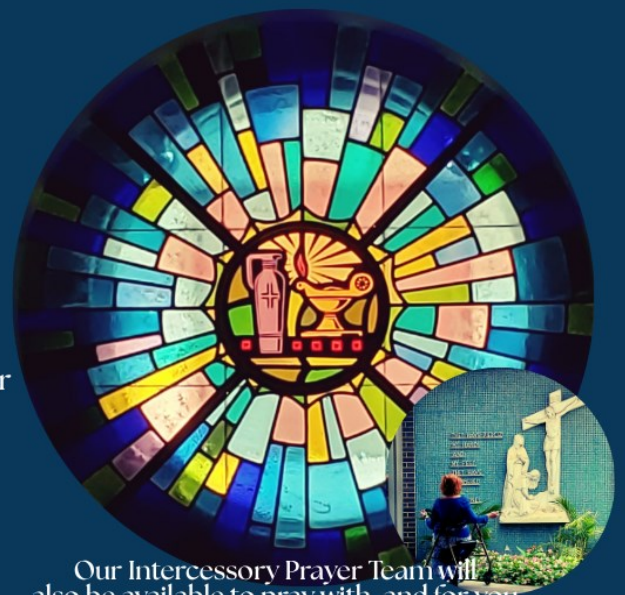

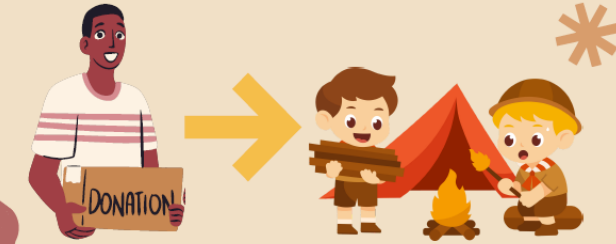

May Crowning: May 13th

May Crowning is a traditional Catholic ritual held during the month of May, typically during our School Mass on the Wednesday following our celebration of First Communion @ IC. It is a solemn procession featuring our First Communicants & 8th Grade students. Roses are presented to Mary by students who comprise Mary's Court, selected because they best exemplify the virtues of Mary. At the close of the procession, a statue of the Blessed Virgin is crowned with a crown of flowers by one of our 8th Grade students honoring Mary as "the Queen of May." Special Marian prayers & hymns are also featured during our Mass.

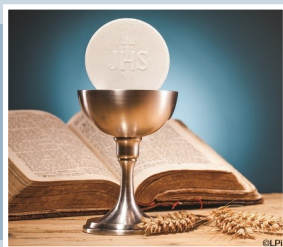

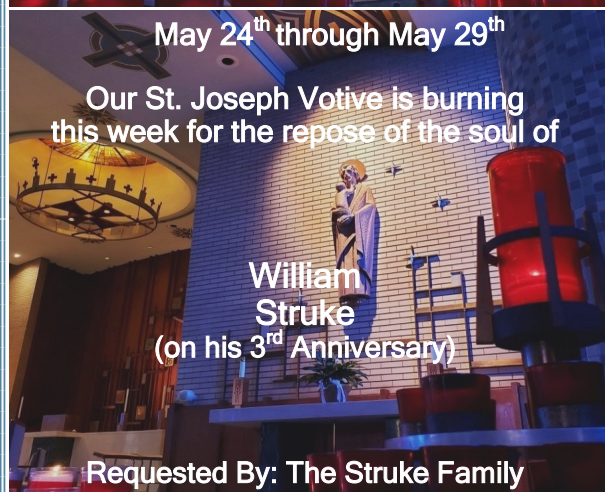

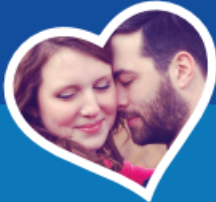
