Dear Parishioners,

Every year we publish our parish financial report in order to be transparent about the state of our parish and its future. Money and funds are a necessary component of a successful parish precisely because of the services, sacraments, and ministries we provide. Please review the following reflections as well as the full financial report, with notes from our Director of Operations, *Vince Kennedy*.



Our Challenges:

One number that may surprise you is the cost of running our school. Making a school competitive, affordable, and stable is no easy task. To that end, I am grateful to the leadership of our school for living and growing within our means. One source of difficulty is the rising costs of energy. As they rise, we are looking for ways to offset them, become more efficient, and preserve the small surplus we maintain. Our Church's energy costs are less, but still high as well. As salaries, materials, and utilities continue to climb, we are doing our utmost to control costs while also improving where desired and necessary.


Our Hope:

Enrollment has remained steady these past few years, which I feel is positive. Our younger grades have solid enrollment which projects for healthy enrollment for the foreseeable future. The past 5 years of my pastorate have seen us addressing significant deferred maintenance, while also addressing areas of need, concern, and even desire on our campus. The completion of our IC Rose Garden in front of our church, the abatement of asbestos tile and installation of new flooring in the second half of our school, and the tuckpointing of areas of critical need at our school rank among the important projects accomplished. This also goes along with many necessary repairs done to both school and church infrastructure — minor in costs individually, but their volume totaling significant amounts.

We have been able to complete these projects with your generous support of our school fundraisers, donations to our maintenance fund, and regular giving.

Our Vision:

As we look to the future, we will welcome *Fr. Michael Wyrzykowski* to our parish shortly before Christmas. As he steps in and I temporarily step away for my Sabbatical (*January 1 – June 30, 2025*), we look forward to working together on a variety of ministries and projects upon my return. Having a second priest on staff will not only allow me to invest time in ministries, ideas, and projects which my current schedule does not afford, but also allows me to entrust ministries and projects to him. I am very excited about the prospects that await us this coming year. *In particular*: expansion of our evangelization and



prayer, the further support of our teen ministries, and the development of new sacramental formation (adult and child). Many of our volunteer leaders have been energized by recent training, retreats, conferences, and opportunities. My primary vision is to support our leaders to allow us to reach a wider array of people.

Our Gratitude:

Last year, I outlined a general goal and request of our parishioners for giving. Thank you for supporting that vision, especially in your giving to Christmas, Easter, Music, and Maintenance. Similarly, it is very positive that our online giving is nearly equal to our in-person giving, a percentage that is past the average of most parishes. My personal thanks to our staff, volunteers, and, of course, all of you, for making what we have accomplished so far possible.

NOTES

- Immaculate Conception saw a slight increase in Ordinary Church Revenue this past fiscal year. Our electronic support through Give Central increased to over 7%, while our Envelope and Cash collections dropped. The pleasant surprise this past Fiscal Year is our Christmas and Easter Collection increased \$14,000 over the previous Fiscal Year. The \$50,000 increase to Other Church Revenue is attributed to the Capital Gains associated with the Stock Market increase of our School Endowment. Please consider using Give Central as a means to supporting our Parish.
- Immaculate Conception continues to provide various ministries to our community. Our Alpha program, started four
 years ago, has well over 150 Alumni, many of which participate in the Connect Group. This past year, the IC Teen Club
 was started and has been a great success. RCIA and Bible Study continues under the guidance of Deacon Rick and
 Carol Moritz.
- We continue to make Capital Improvements to our Parish. Last Summer, with the proceeds from the 60 for 60 campaign, the IC Rose Garden was completed. Phase 2 of the Asbestos Abatement and New Flooring for the school was also completed last summer along with the spot tuckpointing of the school building. In time for this past summer, the retrofit of the church Air Conditioning was completed.
- Under the guidance of Mrs. Canzoneri and Mrs. Fitzgerald, the school continues to thrive and evolve. At the end of last
 Fiscal Year a program was created to provide full time security for the school. Agreat deal of Thanks for the time and
 efforts that the HolyName Men's Club, the Parents Club and the TRIP Program for their continued support of our School
 and Parish.


