

A New Church Year - New And Old Ways To Pray

Hello and blessed Advent to you all. As we begin this new Church year, we rededicate ourselves to God and reliving the mysteries of our faith.


Naturally, I invite you to join us for our regular worship, whether weekly on Sundays or daily. Secondly, our **Advent Vespers** begins on **December 2nd** and continues **each Tuesday at 6:30 P.M.** through the Christmas Season **until January 6th**. Our **Parish Reconciliation Service** will be on **Wednesday, December 17th** at 6:30 P.M. We will also have Adoration during that time.



We will also offer some new ways to pray as a community:

+Hallow: in partnering with Hallow, we have access to a number of prayers.

1. On Android or Apple, search "Hallow." The icon will look like the image above.
2. Download and install. From there it will ask for your name and email to register.
****please note: though you can buy the premium version (\$70/year) at this time, you may skip that part of registration.**
3. Once you have done that, you will see at the bottom of your phone 5 icons:
 Home, Discover, Bible, Community, and Me
4. In clicking "Community," (see image) search **Talcott** and find our parish.
5. From there you can publicly request prayers from your fellow parishioners – if you wish – and also join the wider community in prayer.



One such new opportunity in prayer is *Advent25*, a daily Advent Reflection. Featuring radio-play style reflections, readings and meditations on Scripture, poetry and prose, **this premium content is available to all in our parish group for free.** We will have additional premium content available for free throughout the whole year (e.g., in January, Lent, and the Easter Season).

My goal is to have 100 members (47 to go!) by Immaculate Conception (December 8th), and 150 members active in our parish by the New Year. As we gain new members, I also have premium subscriptions to gift, so I will have some little events planned for you all too.

This app is suitable for all ages, and the free version can be utilized by everyone. If you need assistance getting the app, please let me know and we will be happy to assist.

In everything we do this Advent, I hope we can pray together, growing closer to God as we relive the mystery of His Incarnation.
