

An Overview Of Our Previous Financial Year (Fiscal Year 2022-2023)

Dear Parishioners,

My gratitude to all of you as I have written and spoken to you about our financial outlook over these past few weeks. Likewise, I wanted to present to you our current financial status at Immaculate Conception.

One area of note is that our regular Sunday giving has improved by 9% over this past year, for which I am very grateful. Overall, we saw an increase in revenue by about 2%, while also reducing our expenses by 4.5%. You can review some of this from last weekend's bulletin (available on our website if you no longer have a hard copy on hand).

During this past year, you will also notice that we have spent about \$430,000 dollars on capital improvements, chief among them our asbestos abatement and flooring project in our school. This also includes the improvements to our church made possible through your generous support of our *60 for 60* Campaign. I hope you can see that the money you have entrusted to us has been utilized prudently, effectively, and in a timely manner. Thank you for helping us to upgrade both our church and school to serve you better!

We have also grown as a community to over 2,000 registered families, while also expanding our school community and the number of sacraments that we perform. We continue, with the help of our volunteers, to strive to serve our families in new ways. I appreciate your support as my staff and I work together with our current leaders to continue to raise up new leaders so that we might better serve the needs of our IC community going forward.

Among our new efforts has been an emphasis on hospitality in its many forms, the creation of an ongoing leadership formation program (our Connect group), and other small group formation meetings.

Likewise, we have seen our parish grow over time. In a rough estimate, I have seen our parish increase our regular Sunday attendance by approximately 125 people over this past year. I am encouraged, along with my staff and volunteers, to see and welcome so many new faces joining us for worship. Some of you have even volunteered as leaders in various ministries at IC—thank you for involving yourself in the life of our parish!



Please take a moment to review these financials for yourselves. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact either myself or *Mr. Kennedy* (our Director of Operations).

In conclusion, I wanted to thank *Vince Kennedy* for preparing these materials as well as for overseeing our finances. My thanks also extend to *Lisa Kessler*, who assists with our school and parish finances, and to the members of our *Finance Council* as well. Similarly, *Sue Canzoneri*, our Principal, and *Tina Fitzgerald*, our Assistant Principal, for their work with staff, parents, and students. I also wanted to acknowledge *Mike LaHaye*, who works behind the scenes to maintain our campus. Lastly, to all our staff here at IC, my thanks for all the many ways that they serve our parish and community.

Thank you for your support and commitment to making Immaculate Conception what it is. I am excited to share with you part of my future vision for our parish next weekend.

Financial Report For Fiscal Year Ending June, 2023

NOTES

- Immaculate Conception saw an increase in Ordinary Church Revenue of 9.0% over last Fiscal Year. Our
 electronic support through Give Central increased to over 11%. It also appears that our Mass attendance
 has increased because our loose cash and checks have increased. Please consider using Give Central
 as a means to supporting our Parish.
- We celebrated the 60th Anniversary of our Church on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception last December. Our campaign of \$60K for 60 years was a great success. The improvements, funded through your generous support, allowed for a new Steinway Piano, refurbishing of our Altar Furniture and the polishing of the Altar Ornaments and Tabernacle.
- We continue to make Capital Improvements to our Parish. Phase 1 of the Asbestos Abatement and New Flooring for the school was completed last summer. The Parking Lots were restored and resurfaced with new Striping. We also began work on the Immaculate Conception Rose Garden.
- Our school continues to prosper under the guidance of Mrs. Canzoneri and Mrs. Fitzgerald. The school enrollment increased over FY2022. Many Thanks for the efforts of the Holy Name Men's Club, the Parents Club and the TRIP Fund for their continued support of our School and Parish.
