IC Teen Club Service Trip @ Elmwood Park Community Church Food Pantry & Clothes Closet

Our Teen Club had their first service trip on Saturday, October 14th. Because our focus in September was on food insecurity, our service trip was at the Elmwood Park Community Church Food Pantry & Clothes Closet. EPCC has quite the program as they are able to feed up to 450 individuals in and near their community on a weekly basis, and supply as many with much-needed clothing via their clothes closet.

On Saturday morning, the boys in the group worked on the lower level in the food pantry, helping with carrying groceries, restocking food, and greeting pantry guests. The girls in the group joined me upstairs in the clothes closet, where we sorted through a room of contractor-sized garbage bags that were filled with clothing donations. The girls were tasked with emptying the bags, sorting them, hanging them according to their category, all so the closet could shift their supply to winter-only clothing. I would bet the girls sorted through a minimum of (10) bags.

Following this, once the pantry was officially closed at noon, the kids joined together on the first floor to help with some additional restocking of the pantry, then took a much-needed break of playtime in their gym. All in all, it was a fabulous event – the kids worked SO hard, and were thanked constantly by everyone they encountered. My Request To The Parish



Last week I wrote about the areas of Growth and Need for Immaculate Conception, which can be summarized as: (1) sustaining and expanding our current ministries, (2) investing in leaders and entrusting them to run and create these ministries, (3) continuing to maintain and upgrade our campus to be inviting for our parishioners and guests, and (4) bringing on another priest to help form leaders and run ministries.

You can review all of the previous information on our Donate section of our website (icchicago.org/donate). Below represents some trends, suggestions, and where I hope to see our finances moving forward.

Trends

Our *Sunday Collection* from last year is up 9% from last Fiscal Year ('22)

Our online giving has gone up 11%
and represents 42% of our total Sunday giving (~\$290, 000)

Loose cash and checks are up 22%
and represents about 23% of our total Sunday giving (~\$166,000)

+ **We attribute the larger online portion of giving** to new families who register with our parish and school. We encourage all families to establish online giving as a way to fit their monthly financial needs and support our parish.

If you feel so inclined to give online or update your current gift, you can do so at *Give Central*.

+ **We attribute loose cash and checks** to a larger number of people attending our weekend Masses. It is nice to see new faces at Immaculate Conception every week! We appreciate people giving cash anonymously, and we encourage them to consider registering with us (if they have not already) and to give electronically. Giving electronically allows us to have a better understanding of regular income and budget more effectively.

+**To those who already give electronically:** we appreciate your willingness to give regularly! One trend that many churches have noticed, however, is that people tend to less frequently update their gift after initially establishing it. If you offer a regular online gift to IC, please consider reassessing your current contribution to see if you can give a little more to support our mission.

Our Hope

The majority of gifts we receive in our parish range from \$500 - \$2500 annually (~80%). Even small increases of your gift would produce a great cumulative effect.



If you give \$10 a week, would you consider giving \$15?

If you give \$20 a week, would you consider giving \$25?

If you give \$50 a week, would you consider giving \$60?

Our total collection for the '22 -23 Fiscal year was ~\$825,000 (excluding tuition for Religious Education).

+ I would like to increase our income to afford an associate pastor, invest in the growing ministries we currently have, and continue to make repairs and upgrades to our campus. For that, I estimate that \$905,000 would cover those needs, representing a 10% increase.

+ In the future, for Fiscal year '24 - '25, I would like to see our total income reach \$970,000, which represents a 7% increase of the previous number. This will allow for the creation of new programs and development of our current ministries.


