The Current And Future Outlook Of Immaculate Conception...

Blessings to everyone and my thanks for taking the time to read this.

I announced last week at our Masses that I would make a series of presentations during the month of October on stewardship and finances. As we continue to prepare materials for your consideration, please review what my mindset is behind this effort:

Parishes in the Archdiocese of Chicago for decades have excelled with Capital Campaigns. We can look at our Parish Center project nearly 20 years ago, *To Teach Who Christ Is* (Archdiocesan Campaign), our Sound System project, and most recently, 60 for 60. In all of these efforts, we exceeded and accomplished our goals—for this, we are incredibly grateful.

On the other hand, it has been much more difficult in the Archdiocese to maintain regular giving, which lies at the heart of operational expenses, growth, and development. Many parishes struggle, and even strive for breaking even. As a non-profit entity, it is true that we do not exist to generate enormous profits. We do, however, live within our means which, as costs and inflation proceed, becomes smaller and smaller. Looking at our history, everyone at our parish *has* increased their donations over time and we have been able to match inflation, so I do not doubt that you are also conscious of this dynamic.

My hope in this month is to present our current financials (2022 Fiscal Year Report) on October 15th, and then to publish a list of goals (both near-term and long) the following weekend and propose the path that I think can get us there more quickly.

No Capital Campaign can provide the resources needed to bring on another priest, another staff member, or even address the need for ongoing formation of volunteers, staff, and priests. Only regular giving can assist these needs. Similarly, thanks to your continued generosity, I estimate that in the past 7 years, we have accomplished nearly 2+ million dollars of improvements and deferred maintenance to our school and church. We have done this by taking advantage of timely opportunities and with confidence in your generosity. As we catch up on certain things, sometimes left unattended for over 25 years, the costs of keeping our campus healthy will go down too.

Here is one example of my decision-making process: although not exclusively tied to money — as finding the right person is important too — one of the considerations for my not choosing to have an associate pastor is that it would have our parish operate at a deficit that would affect our savings. In doing so, we would greatly limit the future ability of our parish to grow. I made this decision in consultation with the bishop and leaders of our parish, and decided that I was confident in the support of my staff and volunteers to allow us to function as we needed to at the time.

This is not only about 'having more,' but also about spending effectively and prudently. As we illuminate our path going forward, it will provide you with the ability to see what we have done, what we are doing, and what we hope to do. However you choose to support us, know that all of us at IC are extremely grateful for your trust and confidence thus far.

A Note Of Welcome...



The Gift That Gives Back...

It never ceases to amaze me how often I fall into the trap and end up grumbling about the greatest gifts in my life. A husband, children, a life that is full almost to bursting: these are things for which I once begged God. These are the jewels in the crown of my life.

Oh, but the children need care. Constant care. And a husband — a real flesh-and-blood creation of God, entrusted to me by God, to help me be holy and relying on me for holiness in turn — well, that relationship is a lot of work, isn't it? And a "full life" — I laugh to think of it, and then I blush with shame, because I admit sometimes, I do yearn for a life that is a little less ... full. A full life can leave you awfully tired at the end of the day.

I would imagine it's the same for everyone, no matter your life circumstances or vocation. Your greatest blessings are also those things that require much of you, more than you imagined you would ever be asked to give. The biggest jewels make the crown heavy.

But if we had any of these gifts without the effort it takes to maintain them, would they be half as sweet?

In this same way, the work of the vineyard is opened to us through baptism; we are given the chance to produce fruit for the kingdom. It's a chance we never dared to dream would be given to us.

It's a gift. But just like with any gift worth having, it requires effort. Upkeep. Work.

It requires that we give in return. And it's the giving that somehow, mystically, transforms us. It's the giving that turns into the gift itself.
