



#### Source & Summit Missal: An Addition To Our Musical Offerings Coming To A Pew Near You

In the next couple of weeks, you will see a new musical resource in our hymnal holders: the *Source & Summit 2024 Companion Edition Missal*. This Missal is meant to serve as a companion booklet in a parish that already has a hymnal, such as *Breaking Bread*. *Source & Summit* will be our new hymnal beginning in Advent. In the meantime, we will be using their Companion Missal as an introduction to some of the new music.



*Scott:* Why the change? The reasons are varied, with possibly the most important being congregational participation. Father Matt and I want to take every opportunity to make accessible to the broadest group possible full and active participation in the Liturgy. Being active in communal prayer is precisely why we gather on the weekends. We want to lift our voices in praise to our gracious and loving God.

*Fr. Matt*: In Seminary, chant was taught to all levels of singers and was intended to allow even the most limited singer to offer the Mass. We also used to chant the psalms together. Although there were no advanced harmonies, having two hundred young men singing psalms and hymns together made for an inspiring experience. I know that from my time in High School Seminary to now, those experiences have remained with me and have since been what I wanted to bring to the experience – not just the music itself, but the uplifting experience of prayer.

Scott: You may be asking, what is so different from our current hymnal Breaking Bread? Mainly, the musical notations for the entrance, offertory, and Communion antiphons are printed. We would very much like to add these to our weekend liturgies. Source & Summit says it best: "Give your congregation everything it needs in a single book: the sung Order of Mass, 15 Mass Settings, Sunday Readings and Daily Proper's, Responsorial Psalms and Alleluias, over three hundred time-tested hymns, and a rich selection of devotional prayers. An all-in-one annual missal designed to help your parish elevate the liturgy." IC wants a "complete resource to help inspire deep participation, increase reverence, and form missionary disciples along the way of beauty."

Have you ever noticed when the congregation is most engaged in sung Liturgy? Believe it or not, it is when we chant. Sung chant is the most accessible form of congregational singing. With familiarity comes active participation. *Source & Summit* provides a better opportunity for us to do just that. I would ask everyone to give the new resource a try, while keeping in mind that it takes more than a month or two to become accustomed to a new in-pew resource. We will be looking forward to your feedback along the way. Please engage in this new effort; with a little time, we know you will hear the result.

If in the end, however, we decide that the resource is not for us, we can always switch to another as it has an annual subscription (like what we already use.) Our weekend choir will continue to enrich our private prayer with engaging anthems, in both meditation and praise style,

Post-Communion.

We look forward to sharing this new resource with you as the praise of God and the spiritual care of our parish are our top priority.

#### Annual Back To School Bash & IC HNMC Rib Cook-Off






