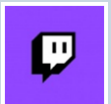

Vocation Journey Updates From Our Seminarians, Deacon Joseph & Jacob

I am returning for my fourth and final year at Mundelein, and my sixth year of seminary. I will be ordained a priest, God willing, at the end of May. Over my deacon summer, I was at our cathedral in Wichita, KS where I had the opportunity to practice my preaching, both in English and Spanish, and to baptize seven babies. A definite highlight of the summer was witnessing my sister's wedding vows and doing her nuptial blessing. There was a wonderful group of young adults who had a social group, as well as some strong Bible studies that I enjoyed being a part of. The youth group leaders did a really good job leading our high school students and helping to build up their faith life and community in a parish where not many attend Catholic school. I also visited the homebound and had the opportunity to do some house blessings. It has been wonderful to experience the vocation of the priest, to be a man of blessing bringing the presence of God into people's lives and situations as best I can, and to see the Holy Spirit working through that. One of my great joys was seeing a couple who have been married civilly for about twenty years have their marriage convalidated in the Church on the 13th. I look forward to becoming involved in ministry as a deacon this year at IC, and for you all to get to know me a little better through my preaching. - Deacon Joseph Mick
